The police department property room is managed by a sergeant and is part of the Homeland Security & Support Services Division.

The Property Room holds all property and evidence filed under a case number. We would need a case number to look up what items we hold for a case. If you do not know your case number, call our records unit first at 651-266-5700. Items we hold need to be released by the Investigator for the case before they can be released to anyone.

The Property Room also contains the Police Photo Lab. If you would like to make a request for photographs, you can do so by faxing a request to us, or providing a request in writing to us. There is a fee for this service to recoup the costs of storage, printing or burning them to a compact disc.
